## TIPS:

Once you login, you can find the viewing area for the Main Stage at the top of the page.

There will be a reset at 12:30 (CST) each day. *Therefore, you will need to refresh your browser page after lunch to view the latest mainstage video feed.*

Can't make it to a session? We are recording the Mainstage and Breakouts, but keep in mind that viewing later means you won't be able to participate actively in the questions and answers.

## 135 BREAKOUTS:

8 different breakout hours will occur over the 2-day conference. Within the eight breakouts, there are 12 breakout “channels” (or tracts, as they are often called at physical conferences). We encourage you to pre-select the breakouts you plan on attending.

### Breakouts will be set up in 4 different ways:



#### “Webinar” – *The Most Common*

A main presenter will share for 20 plus minutes followed by 15 minutes of Q&A.

#### “Panel”

3 panelists will respond to questions posed by the moderator, as well as from you as a participant. If you have questions, you let the facilitator in the room know via Chat.



#### “Rapid Fire Roundtable”

A group of individuals will present best practices and Q&A. They will offer PDF copies of their content.

#### “Digital Patio”

Visit these traditional Zoom rooms, each hosted by a “Patio Host” who is available to chat, answer questions and share perspectives. Come ready to relax and engage!

## HOW TO GO TO YOUR BREAKOUT SESSIONS:

4. Once you are in the Zoom room, you can ask questions via Chat!

### **TIPS:**

Zoom rooms open 5 mins before the session starts.

All rooms have trained facilitators who will greet you when you arrive and be available by chat to answer questions.

Note, all Breakout Zoom rooms (except for Digital Patios) are “Webinar style” and are set to show the presenter’s video and audio only. You will not be visible or heard unless you agree when asked. Either way, you can always submit your questions or comments via Chat.
